History on Display at the Medford Branch Library

Southern Oregon Stitchers, a local chapter of the Embroiderers' Guild of America, is displaying its members' work during the month of July at the Medford Branch Library, 205 South Central Avenue.

Part of the display is a reproduction of the first known embroidery completed on American soil. The original, now housed in the Pilgrim Hall Museum in Plymouth, Massachusetts, was done by Loara Standish, circa 1653. Ms. Standish was the daughter of Captain Myles Standish, of the Mayflower.
