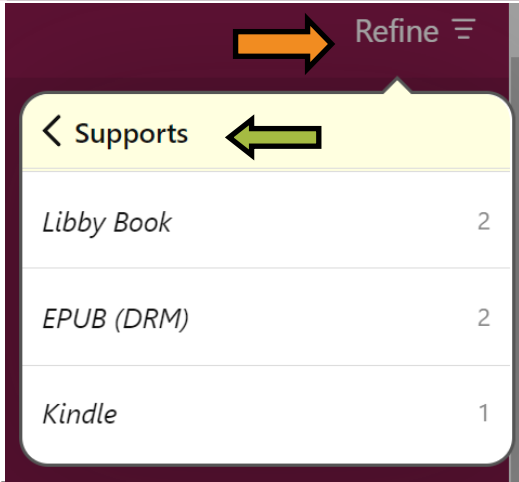




Kindle Books: How to borrow eBooks with your Kindle Paperwhite.

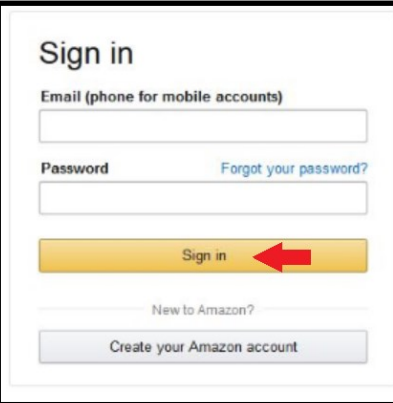
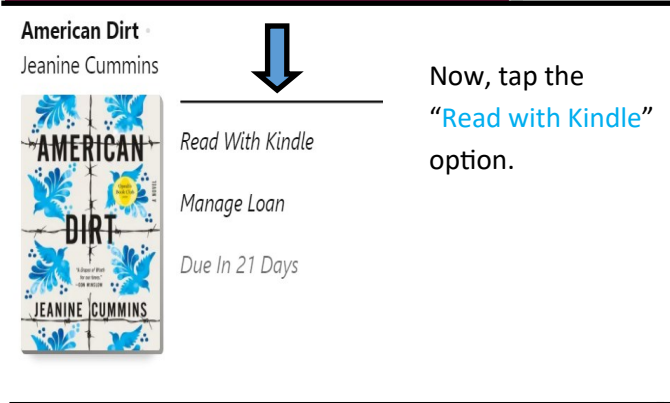


Go to libbyapp.com. On the main screen, select **REFINE**.

Click on the “**Supports**” button and tap “Kindle.” Now the search results will only return Kindle-compatible titles.

Go ahead and find a title that you wish to enjoy.

Tap the “Borrow” button. Next, tap the “Shelf” button at the bottom of the page.



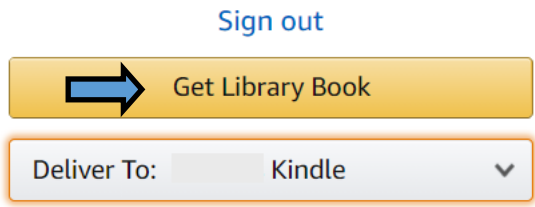
You will then be taken to the Amazon website, where you will be prompted to “**Sign In**”.

Once you have signed in, you will be given the option on the right-hand side of your screen to “**Get library book**” by delivering the book to your Kindle Paperwhite.

Click on “**Get library book**,” then check the home page of your Kindle Paperwhite. The title should now appear there.

Tips and Notes:

If you don’t see the title on your Kindle’s homepage, make sure that your Kindle Paperwhite is connected to Wi-Fi, as an Internet connection is required to deliver and download the title. If you still don’t see the title, make sure you sent the title
