



Kindle Books: How to borrow eBooks with your Kindle Paperwhite.

When browsing or searching for your desired title, you can find a Kindle eBook one of two ways.

1. Once you log into the Library2Go site you can find Kindle eBooks on the main page. On the upper right-hand side of the page, you'll find a "Kindle Books" section that displays only Kindle formatted eBooks.
2. When searching or browsing for your desired title, you can narrow your search by eBook format on the left-hand side of the page, under "eBooks."

Once you determine that the title is in the Kindle eBook format, borrow the title and go to your "Loans."



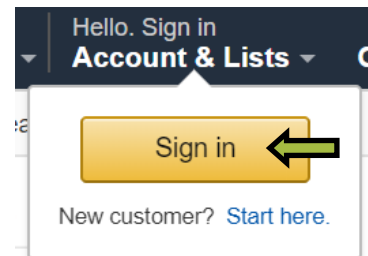

On the Loans page, find your title and select "Read now with Kindle."



You will then be taken to the Amazon website, where you will be prompted to "Sign In" under the "Account & Lists" menu.



Once you have signed in, you will be given the option on the right-hand side of your screen to "Get library book" by

delivering the book to your Kindle Paperwhite.

Click on "Get library book," then check the home page of your Kindle Paperwhite. The title should now appear there.

Tips and Notes:

If you don't see the title on your Kindle's homepage, make sure that your Kindle Paperwhite is connected to Wi-Fi, as an Internet connection is required to deliver and download the title.

If you still don't see the title, make sure you sent the title to the right Kindle device.
